1. Themed Mini-Drive

Ideal for: Schools, corporate groups and Girl Scout and Boy Scout troops.

Length of commitment: A Mini-Drive can last for a couple of days or an entire month. You choose the dates that work best for your group.

Donations are collected using: Large Tupperware bins or boxes (C2C does not provide these).

Steps to coordinating a Themed Mini-Drive:

1. **Choose the date(s) for your drive.**
2. **Choose a drive theme.** Visit our website at www.cradlestocrayons.org for our top ten current needs.
3. **Decide where collection bins or boxes will be set up** (e.g. school lobbies, local libraries, community centers, office lobbies).
4. **Decorate collection bins or boxes.**
5. **Advertise.** We'll provide the flyer.
6. **Deliver the donations to our warehouse and stay for a tour.**

2. One Day "Pass it on" Drive

Ideal for: Families or individuals, clubs, social organizations and faith-based groups.

Length of commitment: 1 day.

Donations are collected using: A 15' or 24' truck.

Steps to Coordinating a One Day "Pass it on" Drive:

1. **Choose a date and location for your drive.** One day drives are typically held on Saturday or Sunday mornings between 10 a.m. and 12 Noon. Ask us about turning your One Day Drive into a fun, family-friendly **Good to Go Drive**.
2. **Advertise.** We'll provide the flyer and press release.
3. **Recruit a volunteer to drive the 15'-24' truck.** C2C can take care of the reservations. You can help us to keep our costs low by contributing the cost of the rental truck. Note that rental agencies require the driver be at least 25 years old.
4. **Deliver the donations to our warehouse and stay for a tour.** We'll have volunteers here to help unload the truck.
